





Offence Data for Average Speed Camera Systems

Data till end of March 2018 and correct as of 9th April 2018

Overview of Content

Offence data for existing or recently concluded average speed camera systems, operated as part of the Scottish Safety Camera Programme, will be published here on a 3 monthly basis and will show data from Apr-11 (where applicable).

Each publication will be made approximately 2 weeks following the end of a quarter and offence data will be confined to calendar/operational year quarters (Jan-Mar, Apr-Jun, Jul-Sep, and Oct-Dec).

Due to the process for driver identification and prosecution and the fact that the data is taken from a live system, the data published is subject to change and previously published data will be refreshed at each publication. This usually affects data for the last 2 quarters although it can also affect previous quarters' data.

A90 Dundee to Stonehaven

On 31st October 2017 this average speed camera system went live. It contains 30 sites across the 51.5 mile stretch of the A90 between Dundee and Stonehaven. This route was previously enforced by fixed and mobile speed cameras and while the previous strategy saw casualties reduce at a number of camera locations along the route, average speed cameras will help to make the entire route that much safer.
