



Offence Data for Average Speed Camera Systems

Data till end of June 2018 and correct as of 13th July 2018

Overview of Content

Offence data for existing or recently concluded average speed camera systems, operated as part of the Scottish Safety Camera Programme, will be published here on a 3 monthly basis and will show data from Apr-11 (where applicable).

Each publication will be made approximately 2 weeks following the end of a quarter and offence data will be confined to calendar/operational year quarters (Jan-Mar, Apr-Jun, Jul-Sep, and Oct-Dec).

Due to the process for driver identification and prosecution and the fact that the data is taken from a live system, the data published is subject to change and previously published data will be refreshed at each publication. This usually affects data for the last 2 quarters although it can also affect previous quarters' data.

Definitions

	Definition
Offences	Total number of camera activations where an offence can be proven to have taken place.
COFPNs Issued	Total number of Conditional Offer of Fixed Penalty Notice (COFPN) issued, for offences committed within the period specified.
Reports to PF	Total number of offenders who have been reported to the Procurator Fiscal, either in place of a COFPN (e.g. excessive speed/foreign licence) or because the COFPN has not been paid, for offences committed within the period specified.

On 1st March 2016 the A9 roadwork average speed cameras went live between Dalraddy and Kincaig. The reduced speed limit was set at 40mph to ensure the safety of road users and the workforce during this section of the dualling of the A9.

A90 Roadworks – Balmedie and Blackdog

On 25th July 2016 the A90 roadworks average speed cameras went live between Balmedie and Blackdog. The reduced speed limit was set at 50mph to ensure the safety of road users and the workforce during the construction of this section of the Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route (AWPR). The average speed cameras are expected to stay in place until the works are completed. This section is due for completion in spring 2017.

A90 Roadworks – Charleston

On 25th January 2017 these A90 roadworks average speed cameras went live. The reduced speed limit was set at 50mph to ensure the safety of road users and the workforce during the construction of this section of the Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route (AWPR). The average speed cameras are expected to stay in place until the works are completed. This section is due for completion in winter 2017/18.

A90 Roadworks – Stonehaven Junction

The reduced speed limit was set at 50mph to ensure the safety of the road users and the workforce during the construction of this section of the Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route (AWPR). The average speed cameras are expected to stay in place until the works are completed.

A90 Dundee to Stonehaven

On 31st October 2017 this average speed camera system went live. It contains 30 sites across the 51.5 mile stretch of the A90 between Dundee and Stonehaven. This route was previously enforced by fixed and mobile speed cameras and while the previous strategy saw casualties reduce at a number of camera locations along the route, average speed cameras will help to make the entire route that much safer.
